Nehemiah 1:1-11

Icebreaker: Does the reality that God desires to use you to accomplish His will excite you or scare you? Why?

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

Read Nehemiah 1:1-11. What strikes you as interesting about the concern Nehemiah shows for his people back in Jerusalem? Why?.

Nehemiah finds hope in the character of God as he is faced with difficult news in regard to Jerusalem in verse 5. How is God's character (who He is) giving you hope in the midst of your circumstances? _____

Nehemiah after reminding himself of the character of God, calls out to God in an attitude of confession and repentance. What does it look like to have a lifestyle of confession and repentance in your relationship with the Lord and others? And why is this important to living in partnership with the God Who Builds? _____

2. ASSESS YOUR LIFE

Living in Partnership with the God who Builds was defined as, "living all of my life and all that I have for all of God's glory. How often would you say that characterizes your life?"
