CURRENT SERIES: I AM
JOHN 10:1-10

1. Jesus' warning to the religious leaders was similar to the warning given to the Jewish leaders in the old testament. Spend some time looking at Ezekiel 34:1-24. Compare and contrast the Jewish leaders actions (both in Ezekiel 34 and John 9) with God's heart toward the people.

2. John 10:9 teaches that Jesus is the single point of entry into salvation, security, and satisfaction. Why is it important to decide if you believe this about Jesus? Are there other doors you have opened or are currently trying to use to find these things? How have you personally experienced Jesus as the door?

3. Jesus says "If anyone enters by me..." How does one enter by Jesus?

4. Do you think that we tend to have a shallow view of "having life abundantly"? Why is that? What are things that we can do to help give us a more accurate picture of Jesus is speaking of when he makes this statement? What is the abundant life Jesus came to bring?

5. What does this passage (John 10:1-10) teach us about the character of God? How does knowing that Jesus is the door lead to an increased worship of him?
