

# LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS

WEEK OF MAY 8, 2016

CURRENT SERIES: I AM  
JOHN 14:1-11

Icebreaker: Have you ever been on a trip and gotten to a spot where you just desired to go home?

1. Put yourselves in the disciples' place. What would they have been thinking in those final days leading up to the cross? How would Jesus' words have comforted their troubled hearts?

2. What is the "tool" Jesus gave to the eleven to overcome troubled hearts? What does that teach us about God? What does that teach us about us?

3. CS Lewis wrote in Mere Christianity, "If I find in myself a desire which no experience in this world can satisfy, the most probable explanation is that I was made for another world." Do you agree with this? Does this help us understand what Jesus was talking about when he spoke of his Father's house? How is what Jesus said about heaven a comfort to us now?

4. What does Jesus mean when he says he is the way? The truth? The life? How can you apply each part of that statement to your own life?

5. "No one comes to the Father except through me" (v.6b) How is this a limiting statement? How is this an inviting statement? What side of that do you tend to focus on? What would you say to the person who would find that statement offensive? Why is it important to wrestle with believing what this statement means for us?
