WORSHIP

Personal Worship (Psalm 9:1-2)

Corporate Worship (Hebrews 10:24-25)

Requires knowing Christ (Hebrews 11:6)

Five Essential Truths about Jesus Christ:

1. Jesus is fully God and Fully Man. (John 1:1; 14)
2. Jesus died on the cross as our substitute. (2 Corinthians 5:21)
3. Jesus rose bodily from the grave. (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)
4. Jesus is seated at the right hand of God. (Hebrews 8:1)
5. Jesus will return to the earth in power and glory. (John 14:3)

APPLICATION

- *Have you trusted Christ personally as your Lord and for the forgiveness of your sins?*
- *Have you been baptized as a believer to declare your faith in Christ? If not, talk to your Life Group leader. We would love to help you take this step of obedience.*

WALK

Walking with Christ is a New Testament picture of the Christian life (Ephesians 4:1).

Walking with Christ involves personal spiritual discipline (1 Timothy 4:7-8) and is accelerated through community (1 John 1:7).

- *Are they negative or positive words?*
- *What are the personal spiritual disciplines?*
- *Is there is specific discipline in which you're growing right now?*

4. Our serving results in personal growth and glory to God.
